I have been in jail ministry (for 20 months now.) and started bringing the messages on my rotation with the CAP Ministry team since July 2019. One (particular) message that I brought to the ladies in (Douglas) County, I spoke about behaviors in the message (that I brought) that Sunday.

The message tended to resonate with so many of the ladies there. One lady ended up sending me a letter to the church. I remembered who she was, because I prayed with her every time I was there on Sundays. When she wrote me, she thanked me for the message I brought and told me that she is now cleaning up her behaviors inside the jail and working on being better when she gets out too. She asked if I could be her mentor as well. That is when I knew, I wanted to keep sharing the message and love of Christ. It was my honor to be a part of a ministry where I could do that and be an encourager to ladies in prison."

You may never have been involved in jail ministry as Janelle, yet God has put a heart of compassion for women who are in jail and prison.

God has great compassion for those who have been abused and responded in various ways that put them on a pathway to prison. God sees them as His children and loves them.
