When entering prison, we mail out an invitation for ladies to request a letter writer. We enclose a Promise Calendar with daily Scriptures, & a Bible reading plan to read the New Testament in one year. Here is one of many letters our writers receive.

### A letter in our mailbox - Difficulty in prison



#### One lady, MS J, writes what was on her heart.

"Thank you for your letter and the Promise Calendar. I greatly appreciate it. I got sentenced 3-5 years for a possession charge. I am a drug addict, but I am not a criminal. I do need Jesus back in my life. I need Him badly. Please pray for my granddaddy that he stays alive and healthy that I might see him again as soon as I get out of prison. I haven't seen him in 10 years. Since my g-ma died, I have been lost and unable to bear going down to visit him. They are in the south My g-ma was the world to me and her funeral was the same day I graduated Lancaster County drug court pro-gram in February. I was to go and see her right after graduation, instead, we lost her a few days before. So please pray for my granddad.

"I was so stupid and started using again instead of going where I was supposed to go and *see him*. He is so important to me and played the biggest role in my life upbringing. Please pray he stays alive and healthy and comfortable so that I can see him and spend time with him again. Thank you. Love, Ms. J "
