NCCW Program Graduation

"The first cohort of students at the Nebraska Correctional Center for Women (NCCW) have successfully completed the yearlong Persevere program, which has equipped them with coding skills to fill high-demand jobs.

"During the 12-month program, the 10 participants spent six hours each day, five days a week, together. They learned coding through virtual instruction, along with wraparound services, including career readiness, life skills development, reentry services and family support. With completion of the program, graduates are prepared for entry level jobs that could include:

Software Developer, Backend Developer, UI/UX Designer, Website Developer, Quality Assurance, Video Game Developer and Data Analyst.

"This program is an important part of our TRANSFORM Nebraska efforts to foster growth, build bridges, and ensure that every person leaving our facilities has a genuine opportunity for a positive reintegration into society,"
